Relative Hazard	Occupancy Classifications	Typical Uses in Walnut Creek
1 (Highest Hazard)	H	Hazardous materials
2	A-1 thru A-4, I, R-1, R-2, R-4	R-2: Multi-Family Residential; A-2: Restaurants with occupant load greater than 50, night clubs, bars; I-1: hospitals; I-3: OSHPD-3; A-3: gyms, community halls, and churches.
3	E, F-1, S-1, M	S-1: Combustible storage; M: retail uses; E: day care facilities and educational facilities; F-1: moderate hazard factory and industrial uses, such as carpets and rugs, bakeries, cameras, photo equipment, boats, beverages with more than 12-percent alcohol content..
4 (Lowest Hazard)	B, F-2, S-2, A-5, R-3, U	B: Office uses; R-3: single family and duplex residential; U: accessory buildings to single family uses; S-2: non-combustible storage; F-2: low hazard factory uses such as gypsum plants, brick and masonry plants
