Field Team Message Form Usage

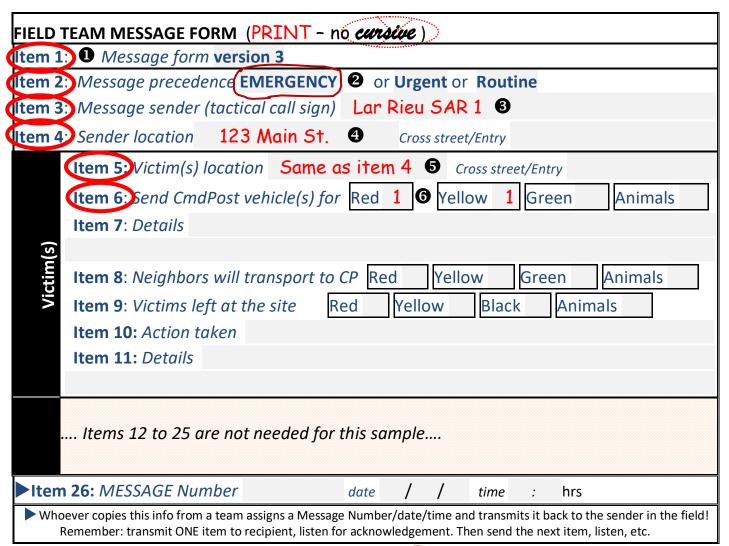
Search and Rescue teams are composed of a radio operator/scribe who waits outside and 2 or more members who do the searching. Radio Supplies: a clip board, a map, Field Team Message Forms, a radio and an assigned Channel.

Assume that you are on a search and rescue team that needs to report to the command post.

- You are tactical call-sign Lar Rieu SAR 1.
- You are at address 123 Main St.
- You found 2 victims at the *same address*. **5**
- You fill out separate Triage Tags for the victims and determine you have
 ONE Red victim and ONE Yellow victim.
- Since RED is a life or death situation, you request *emergency* extraction.

To request extraction, you must fill out a message form as shown below.

- Always fill-in and circle Items 2, 3, and 4!
- Only fill in other items as needed, and then circle their item *Numbers*.
- Always circle **Item 1 1** so you remember to send it!



Then use the radio to transmit the message by sending the circled items one at a time...

Field Team Message Form Usage

To radio the report to the command post -

- Get a turn from Net Control by saying "<your tactical call-sign>."
- Wait until you hear "<your tactical call-sign>, go ahead, OVER."
- Slowly send one item at a time (the other "side" of the communication needs time to WRITE IT DOWN!)
- Net Control repeats back what his/her scribe wrote down.
- If it is correct, you go to the next item.
- If it is wrong, say something like "CORRECTION, address is, OVER".
- Continue for all items that you wrote and circled on the form.

At the end of the message, Net Control sends you a message number, date, and time...

You write this at the bottom of your message form like so...

[4] Continue searching your neighborhood for more victims. Meanwhile the command post will send an extraction team to move the victim(s) to a hospital or the command post.

Congratulations! You may have just saved someone's life!!!
