## WALNUT CREEK DESIGN REVIEW COMMISSION Resolution No. 581 Sign Review No. 77-41 San Marco Master Office Sign and Sign Program

WHEREAS, the Walnut Creek Design Review Commission on June 29, 1977 reviewed a proposal for approval of a 16-square-foot, double-faced, nonilluminated, freestanding master office sign, and a tenant identification sign program located at 1399 Ygnacio Valley Road at the corner of Tampico and Montego; and

WHEREAS, the master sign and sign program are exempt from environmental impact analysis; and

WHEREAS, the Commission made the findings according to Section 10-2.805(e) that the design of the master sign is in architectural harmony with the design of the building; and

WHEREAS, the Commission made the findings as outlined under Section 10-4.301, Chapter 4 (Design Review) Title 10 of the Walnut Creek Municipal Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the freestanding master office sign and the tenant identification sign program as shown on the drawings labeled "Exhibit A" dated June 29, 1977 are approved subject to the following conditions:


- The illumination for the master office sign shall consist of four lighting fixtures fitted with 150 watt lamps as shown on the plan labeled "Exhibit B" and shall be screened with low growing landscaping as acceptable to staff.
- 2. The master office sign shall not encroach the right of way.
- 3. The wood carved sign design shall be used for any tenant identification.
- 4. The tenant sign shall only be placed on that portion of the building occupied by the particular business.


