Non-Residential CalGreen Code Checklist

The provisions of individual sections of California Green Building Standards Code, <u>Chapter 5</u> apply to <u>newly constructed</u> non-residential buildings, building <u>additions</u> of 1,000 square feet or greater, and/or building alterations with a permit valuation of \$200,000 or above. The provisions of California Green Building Standards Code, Chapter 5 shall also apply to the initial tenant improvements to a project.

The City of Walnut Creek requires compliance with the California Green Building Standards Code Mandatory Measures of Chapter 5. Additional tier requirements are not adopted. However, please note that the City of Walnut Creek has amended Section 5.106.5 for Electric Vehicle Charging requirements. Please see IB #? (insert link) for more information.
